**Crompton Named Distinguished Professor

On September 1, 2000, Dr. John Crompton was promoted to the rank of Distinguished Professor at Texas A&M University. John becomes only the 3rd person from his college and approximately the 40th person at Texas A&M to receive this designation.

Most of the other A&M Distinguished Professors are international superstars, with membership in the Academy of Science or Engineering, recipients of a Nobel or equivalent Prize/award, etc.

In order to receive the DP designation, the individual must be shown to be in the 5% of people in their field worldwide, and someone who has made contributions that have significantly influenced scholarship and practice.
